Event Rules:

1. Only one team per college/university can participate. A Team should consist minimum of ten (10) participants and maximum of 20 participants.
2. Reporting time to the event and sequence of the competition must be strictly followed by the participants.
3. The duration of a Nukkad Natak will be from 10 to 20 minutes. A warning bell will be given after 15 minutes. A Team exceeding time shall be disqualified.
4. Teams using any props / Costume / Dressing must bring all their requirements and must be ready well in time as per instructions of the organizer. No Props or costume or any material will be provided by the host.
5. The Competition will be conducted in a "Street" like open place and hence no microphones, Speakers, Music systems will be allowed or available. Teams can sing / dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.

6. Teams must rehearse / practice the play well in advance. No Time for rehearsal / Stage practice / final rehearsal will be given during the competition.
7. Participants should be bona fide students of their respective college/university.
8. Teams should maintain decency and decorum in the behaviour, attire and performance.
9. Language should be Hindi/ English. **The script must not contain anti-government/ nation/ any community sentiments etc.**
10. Decision of the Judges will be final and binding on all teams.
11. The teams should submit an official letter from their respective institutes signed by the competent authority, mentioning the name of participants latest by 28 February 2019 to Dr Varun Gulati, Associate Professor, Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, 15, Janpath – New Delhi 110001.
12. **All the teams must attend Prize distribution ceremony. The absentees shall not be treated as participants.**

Prize:

- “Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Trophy for the Best Street Play” will be awarded to the winning team.
- Runner up team will be awarded with a shield.
- All the participants will be given a certificate of participation issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India.
- An award for Best Actor, Best Actress, and Best Script will be given.
