Bharat Raksha Parv, Amity International School, Gurugram

As part of **Bharat Raksha Parv (BRP)**, an initiative of Dainik Jagran dedicated to honouring the Armed Forces and fostering a deeper understanding of the values of courage, service and patriotism, a special interaction was organised with students of **Amity International School, Sector 43, Gurugram** on **18 August 2026**.

The session provided students an opportunity to engage in a meaningful interaction and understand the responsibilities of citizens towards the nation. The Director, Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, addressed the students and spoke extensively on the vision of Viksit Bharat and the roadmap for transforming India into a developed nation.

A key focus of the interaction was the Constitution of India, which was highlighted as the guiding document that defines the rights, responsibilities and values of citizens. The Director emphasised that building a Viksit Bharat is not solely the responsibility of the Government, but requires active participation, discipline, integrity and a strong sense of civic duty from every citizen, including the youth.

The Director also elaborated on the Saptadhara vision articulated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister and explained its various dimensions in detail. The students were sensitised to how these seven streams of strength can contribute to India's overall progress by strengthening areas such as social development, infrastructure, technology, human capital, innovation and inclusive growth. The discussion highlighted how collective efforts in these areas can accelerate India's journey towards becoming a Viksit Bharat.

The interaction also connected the ideals of national service and patriotism with the everyday duties of citizens. Students were encouraged to understand that contributing to the nation's development can take many forms, including responsible citizenship, respect for the Constitution, excellence in education, innovation, social responsibility and commitment to the larger public good.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, during which students actively engaged with the speaker. Overall, the interaction was an engaging and insightful session that encouraged students to reflect on their role in nation-building and their contribution towards the vision of Viksit Bharat.
