# Report on “Samaveshi Rajya Samvaad – Himachal Pradesh Chapter” (Him Milan Initiative)

Dr. Ambedkar International Centre (DAIC), under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, successfully organized the “**Samaveshi Rajya Samvaad – Himachal Pradesh Chapter**” under its *Him Milan* initiative on **12th March 2026** at **Bhim Hall, DAIC, New Delhi**.
